ADMISSION PREREQUISITE

For admission into the Evening MBA Program candidates must have graduation degree from any discipline obtaining at least 6 (Six) points based on the calculations shown in the following table with no more than one third class/division for all levels of examination.

Application can be lodged with appeared certificate. However, candidates applying with appeared certificate (having completed all written and viva-voce examination) must submit their Final Result (**certificate/mark sheet/transcript**) on the day of viva-voce.

ADMISSION ASSESSMENT INFO.

Applicants seeking enrollment in the Evening MBA Program are required to sit for an MCQ Admission Test covering following sections:

Mathematics	30%
General Knowledge and Current Affairs	40%

ACADEMIC YEAR & SEMESTER

The duration of the program is 2 (two) academic years divided into four semesters. Two semesters will be offered in a year. The entire program must be completed within 5 (five) academic years.

COURSE CURRICULUM

The Evening MBA Program comprises 20 (twenty) courses consisting of 15 (fifteen) prerequisite courses and 5 (five) specialized courses. Total marks in each course shall be distributed in percentage as follows:

COURSE WAIVER

The students with master degree or 4 year bachelor degree from any recognized University/Institute may qualify for a waiver of maximum 21 credit hours (seven courses) and students with 3 year bachelor degree may also qualify for a waiver of maximum 12 credit hours (four courses) provided that they have obtained at least 50 percent marks or corresponding letter grade B in similar courses offered in the program.

WEEKLY CLASS SCHEDULE

Classes will be held on every **Friday** and **Saturday** in the Afternoon.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS & AWARD

The Evening MBA Program shall be of 66 (sixty six) credit hours of which 60 (sixty) for course work, 3 (three) for viva-voce and 3 (three) for internship program. The students shall be awarded the MBA degree by the University of Rajshahi on the recommendation of the Departmental Academic Committee. The students completing the academic requirements with the minimum CGPA of 2 (two) will be eligible for the degree.
