Course Description:

The Certificate Course in Spanish is of six months' duration consisting of one paper carrying 100 marks in total. The final examination will be held at the end of the semester. Results will be published in grading system.

Course Objectives:

To help learners develop knowledge and skills of Spanish for study and employment in contexts where Spanish is used and also to work with people from Spanish in home context.

Course Learning Outcomes:

- 1. Students will be familiar with Spanish alphabet, and sound system of Spanish.
- 2. They will have working knowledge of Spanish vocabulary.
- 3. They will be able to read, write, speak and listen Spanish effectively.

Course Duration: 6 Months / 120 Hours

Pedagogy:

The methodology adopted for teaching comprises of lectures, exercises, tutorials, audio visual. The Department

follows a continuous evaluation system such as class test / exam and tutorial.

Level: A1

Spanish A1 is an introduction level to Spanish language and focuses on the four key areas of foreign language study: reading, writing, listening and speaking. Students in this course will

learn Spanish phonemes and basic vocabulary and they will be expected to master proper Spanish sentence constructions, articles and adjectives, subject-verb agreement, and regular and irregular verb.

- The family and describing people
- · Formal and informal ways of addressing people
- Common everyday objects

- Leisure activities and sports
- · Likes and dislikes
- Public places in a town
- The time, days and months
- · Seasons and the weather

- Demonstrative pronouns

- Noun-adjective agreement
- Basic verbs of present tense (ser, estar, comer, vivir, trabajar etc.)
