- Submit original research abstracts.
- Select a topic from the major focus areas.
- Abstract should be maximum 300 words.
- Extended abstract should be within 4 pages with 1.5-line space, Times New Roman font style.
- Use the QR codes below for submission and registration.

Guidelines for oral presentation

- Slides to be organized in Power Point Presentation into introduction, objectives, methodology, results, conclusion and recommendation/s(in any).
- Each presenter will be given 7 minutes to deliver the presentation.
- After 5 minutes of presentation, a warning bell will be rung to finish the rest of the presentation by next 2 minutes.

Guidelines for Poster presentation

- **Title:** Specific, precise, clear topic title (Paper size width 40 inches and height 48 inches)
- **Authors:** Authors, affiliations, and underline presenter name.
- **Background:** Research problem and brief context (max 5 sentences, 3 references).
- **Objectives:** Main goal of the study.
- **Methodology:** Study design, data, sample, and methods.
- **Results:** Key findings with data, tables, and figures.
- **Conclusion:** Implications and recommendations.
- **References:** Maximum 6 references.
